- **Floats were on display for public viewing** along Sierra Madre and Washington Boulevards after the parade on Wednesday, January 1 from 1 to 5 p.m., and Thursday, January 2 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Admission is \$10 free for children 5 and younger. Tickets may be purchased at the venue until 3 p.m. each day.
- **Rose Parade Broadcasters:** The Rose Parade 2014 was televised live in Panama by Telemetro Canal 13 and in the United States by the following TV stations: ABC, Hallmark Channel, HGTV, KTLA5, NBC, RFD-TV, Sky Link TV and Univision. In addition to Panama, international terrestrial broadcasters included Argentina, Australia, Europe, Bolivia, Chile, china, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, Fiji, Guam, Guatemala, Honduras, India, Indonesia, Jamaica, Japan, Korea, Mexico, Middle East, New Zealand, Nicaragua, Paraguay, Peru, Philippines, Puerto Rico, Singapore, Taiwan and Trinidad and Tobago.
